

1. AWARDS & POINTS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

3.1	AWARD	POINTS & CONDITIONS
3.2	<i>An animal deemed to have its bottom jaw off the pad will be given X & deregistered.</i>	
3.3	Fair (F)	0-74 (No Udder min.)
3.4	Good (G)	75-79 (Udder min 23 points)
3.5	Good Plus (GP)	80-84 (Udder min 25 points)
3.6	Very Good (VG)	85-89 (Udder min 27 points)
3.7	Excellent (EX)	90-100 (Udder min 30 points)

3.7.1 Cows must be at least 3 years old, in milk, and on their 2nd lactation.

3.7.2 Second lactation cows can receive a maximum 91 points.

3.7.3 Cows that are deemed eligible by a classifier to be scored 94 points or higher will be assessed by two classifiers (including the initial nominating classifier) within a period of two weeks of the initial inspection. The second inspection must be approved by the classification convenor.

3.8 Superior Type & Production (STP):

3.8.1. Must hold an EX (old VHC) Award and on reinspection an udder minimum of 28

3.8.2 Must have lifetime production of 1200 kg protein.

3.8.3 Must be in milk at the time of inspection & may be requested to be miked out.

3.8.4 Classifier must sight the cow's official herd recording information.

3.8.5 The award carries the age of which it was gained e.g. aged 7 = STP7.

4. RESUBMITS

- 4.1 Animals may be resubmitted in an attempt to receive higher points.
- 4.2 A resubmitted animal will hold her current record if the points are not raised.
- 4.3 You will need to provide the classifier with the points and award held by the animal.
- 4.4 A cow may be submitted for an STP award having gained an EX in the same lactation.

1. FEES AND CONDITIONS: (All fees include GST)

- 1.2 Subject to Jersey Australia board discretion, the herd visit fee may not be refundable if a booked classification visit is cancelled
- 1.3 All animals submitted for classification **must** be registered with Jersey Australia.
- 1.4 Only the number of cows submitted will be classified
- 1.5 The animals should be in an enclosed area, either concrete or mown grass.
- 1.6 Classifiers will make random checks of tattoo brands of animals being classified.
- 1.7 Members will be notified at least 7 days prior to the classifier visit.
- 1.8 No animal will be penalised due to defects caused by non-genetic factors.
- 1.9 Cows not calved may be assessed if considered to be close enough to calving to be properly evaluated except for Excellent and STP which must be in milk.
- 1.10 Any animals that are classified without following Jersey Australia Book of Rules conditions will be considered invalid and previous score will stand

2. TWO YEAR OLDS:

- 2.1 Two-year-olds can score a maximum of 88 points.
- 2.2 The data on all two year olds is submitted for inclusion in ABV Type assessment with the exception of bull mothers.
- 2.3 Obvious culls will be classified free of charge.
- 2.4 Two-year-olds are classified to meet both Jersey Australia and ADHIS requirements.

This means there will be a final score plus the composite trait boxes for General Appearance and Mammary System.
