NATIONAL TYPE CLASSIFICATION REGULATIONS FOR 2018

1. FEES AND CONDITIONS: (All fees include GST)

- 1.1 Herd Visit fee \$44.00
Adult Cows \$12.10 per head
Animals resubmitted \$12.10 per head
2 year old heifers (all submitted) \$7.70 per head.
- 1.2 Subject to Jersey Australia board discretion, the herd visit fee may not be refundable if a booked classification visit is cancelled
- 1.3 Cash only members must pay in full for all Jersey Australia services upon application. Account in credit must be enough to cover all animals to be assessed plus 10%
- 1.4 All animals submitted for classification **must** be registered with Jersey Australia.
- 1.5 Only the number of cows submitted will be classified
- 1.6 The animals should be in an enclosed area, either concrete or mown grass.
- 1.7 Classifiers will make random checks of tattoo brands of animals being classified.
- 1.8 Members will be notified at least 7 days prior to the classifier visit.
- 1.9 No animal will be penalised due to defects caused by non-genetic factors.
- 1.10 Cows not calved may be assessed if considered to be close enough to calving to be properly evaluated except for Excellent and STP which must be in milk.
- 1.11 Any animals that are classified without following Jersey Australia Book of Rules conditions will be considered invalid and previous score will stand

2. TWO YEAR OLDS:

- 2.1 Two-year-olds can score a maximum of 88 points.
- 2.2 All two year olds must be submitted for their data to be included in ABV Type assessment.
- 2.3 Obvious culls will be classified free of charge.
- 2.4 Two-year-olds are classified to meet both Jersey Australia and ADHIS requirements.

This means there will be a final score plus the composite trait boxes for General Appearance and Mammary System.
