Terms and Conditions

Eligibility

1. The Jersey All-Australian (JAA) Competition is open to animals registered with the Jersey Australia Herd book and GR1 Female
2. Animals must be photographed within 3 months of winning the respective qualifying show
3. Entries must be submitted to the Jersey Australia office with the completed entry form before the closing date for acceptance each year.
4. The entry form must be completed in its entirety and signed that the animal in the photograph(s) have not had the conformation of the animal altered or modified in any way.
5. The animals must have been shown at a recognised show between the dates of March 1, 2019 and February 28th, 2020
 - a. Name and date of show and class entered must be provided on the entry form
6. Animals can only be entered by the name(s) of the owner of the animal at the qualifying show

Classes

Animals will be judged in the following classes

Senior Jersey Classes

- Mature Cow
- 6-Year -Old
- 5-Year-old
- 4 Years old

Intermediate Jersey Classes

- 3 ½ Year Old
- 3 Years old
- 2 ½ - 3 years
- 2- 2 ½ year-old
- Under 2 Years of Age in Milk

Junior Jersey Classes

- Under 6 months of age at date of show
- 6 months to 12 months at date of show
- 12 months to 2 Years of age at date of show

Premier Classes

- Premier Breeder
- Premier Exhibitor

Judging

- The Jersey All Australian will be judged each year by a maximum of 7 judges. Judges will be selected from the primary jersey show in each state and the IDW judge or as determined by Jersey Australia
- All judges for the JAA must be an officially appointed judge by any Registered Breed Association either in Australia or around the World
- Where 2 shows in each state could be considered the primary jersey show in each state, the Jersey All Australian show judge will alternate between the shows on a year by year basis
- Where a judge officiates at 2 or more of the primary shows or IDW in a competition year, an alternative judge will be appointed by Jersey Australia

Scoring

Class Winners

- Cattle are to be Judged on the presented photograph
- Judges will be required to rank the entries in each class in order from 1 to the total number of entries in each class.
- Ranking points will be added together and the animal with the lowest number of ranking points will be declared the winner
- In the advent of a tie, the animal with the greatest number of 1st places from the judges will be declared the winner
 - a. If the occasion exists that there is a tie and both animals have the same amount of 1st places, then

the countback will work down through the different places until such time a winner is determined

- o If by chance the countback cannot break the tie and declare an ultimate winner, both animals will be awarded a Joint placing.

- Placings will be awarded for 1st 2nd and 3rd placing
- Overarching class awards will not be awarded.

Premier Class Scoring

- The top 10 animals in each class will be awarded a score of 10 to 1 with 10 being awarded to the 1st place in each class for
 - a. Senior Jersey
 - a. Intermediate Jersey
 - a. Junior jersey
- The Exhibitor and Breeder with the most points will be awarded the Premier title

Conditions of Entry

To be eligible for judging in the Jersey All Australian (JAA) Photo Competition the following conditions apply:

1. An animal must.
 - 1.1. Have competed in a recognised show in the respective class it is entering in the JAA
 - 1.2. An animal may enter 2 different classes if it meets the appropriate qualifications for the class and have been entered in 2 different age group classes at different shows over the qualifying year
2. An animal can only be entered once in a JAA class regardless of if the animal wins the respective class at multiple shows.
3. One Photograph only can be submitted in any one year for any class. Each photo must.
 - 3.1. Include the date the photo was taken
 - 3.2. Must not be used for any other class
 - 3.3. Be taken within 3 months of the show where the entrant qualified for the JAA
 - 3.4. Be not modified in any way unless the modification does not change the natural conformation of the animal
 - 3.5. For heifer dry classes, the photo must be taken before the heifer develops an udder and calves for the 1st time
 - 3.6. Milking cows must be photographed during the same lactation that they qualified for entry into the JAA
 - 3.7. An unedited version of the submitted photo must be provided
 - 3.8. Be either printed or in digital form.
 - 3.8.1. Printed photos can be no more 18cm * 13cm in size
 - 3.9. Be in full colour.
 - 3.9.1. Black and white photos will not be accepted
4. Jersey Australia will appoint a competition committee or at least 3 and no more than 5 to review photographs prior to judging.
 - 4.1. Any person who is judging the JAA cannot be a member of this committee
 - 4.2. Photographs will be reviewed randomly.
 - 4.3. The committee will review all photographs to determine if any perceived modification has occurred
 - 4.4. Any entry which has been modified to alter the conformation of the animal at the determination of the competition committee will be immediately disqualified
5. Jersey Australia reserves all rights to use submitted photographs for any purpose that it sees fit.
