



# ADY Travel Scholarship

## Purpose

The ADY Travel Scholarship aim is to provide financial assistance to one-to-two people aged between 21 and 25 years to undertake education, training or unique work experience opportunities overseas. The purpose of the trip must be to contribute to your skills development, leadership, personal growth and experience to enhance your personal role and contribution to the Australian Dairy Industry.

## Value

The value of the scholarship is \$5000. The selection committee may choose to award the scholarship in full to one applicant or split the scholarship into two separate \$2,500 scholarships.

## Applicant Requirements

To apply you must meet the following requirements:

- Aged between 21 and 25 years of age.
- Be available for an interview if requested on Tuesday July 16<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
- Winner(s) to be available for an announcement on Friday July 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024
- Be actively employed in the Australian Dairy Industry or studying an agricultural related course and have an intention to work within the Australian Dairy industry when completed.
- Agree to and sign ADY Code of Conduct for participants.
- Have a valid Australian passport and be able to obtain a visa if required to their destination of choice.
- Have the resources and support to fund costs associated with their intended trip that are not covered by the Scholarship.
- Provide necessary insurance to cover all aspects of the trip.
- Complete the intended trip by June 30, 2025.

## How to Apply

The application must include the following:

- Clearly outline the purpose of your trip, and whether it is intended to provide relevant education, training or a unique work experience opportunity.
  - If a training or educational course, the application must include:
    - Name or the course / training provider.
    - Qualification received at completion of the course.
  - If work experience related the application must include:
    - Business or organisation work experience will be undertaken with.
    - Length of time the work experience will be undertaken.
    - What the work experience will include.
- How you consider the work experience will benefit your capacity to work within the Australian Dairy Industry.
- Confirmation from business or organisation of intention to provide work experience position.
- Provide one written personal reference that must not be a family member or close personal friend, plus 2 additional personal or work-related references.
- Clearly outline any personal time the applicant intends to take whilst overseas.



## Scholarship Reporting Requirements

- The Successful applicant must on return home:
  - Provide a 1500 word or more written report on their trip and experience while overseas to Australian Dairy Youth within 30 days of returning home.
  - Provide a presentation of their trip to a suitable dairy related audience at an event designated by the Australian Dairy Youth Committee within 90 days of returning home from the trip, or as otherwise agreed.
  - Provide the report and a presentation of their trip to any sponsor associated with the trip at an event or meeting as designated by the sponsor within 90 days of returning home from the trip, or as otherwise agreed.
